What is a Clubhouse?

Clubhouse is a place where adults living with mental illness can feel a sense of belonging. At Miracle Clubhouse, members and staff work together to perform needs or tasks that benefit the day-to-day operations of the clubhouse.

These tasks are meant to rebuild sense of dignity, self-esteem, and to regain valuable work skills. This helps our members in their recovery, and also helps them regain entry into community employment.

Membership requirements: Membership is open to adults (age 18 years+) with a mental illness.

Hours: Monday – Friday 8:30am - 4:30pm
Join us anytime within the Work-Ordered Day
Members must sign in and out at front desk

Daily meetings:

Morning: 9:30am Afternoon: 1:00pm

Meetings are held to plan the day, build relationships, sign up for clubhouse needs/tasks, etc.

Orientation for new members:

Welcome!! You are a Member on your first day.

A completed referral & mental health documentation are required

Orientation includes three (3) days of participation

First three (3) days in attendance are free (no membership dues)

Membership paperwork will be completed after the 3rd day

Membership Dues: **\$1/daily (each day in attendance)**

Flexible payment options available

Lunch: Daily between 12:00pm – 12:45pm

Must be present by 11:00am to sign up for lunch each day

No additional charge for lunch (free)

Snack Bar: Daily hours: 8:30am - 9:30am, 10:00am – 11:30am, 1:30pm - 3:30pm
Cash only. Dues must be paid to purchase snacks

RTA bus service: *Main St:* #7, #11, #12, #16, #17 *Warren St:* #8, #14

Parking: Free parking in lot. Use parking lot entrance to enter Clubhouse building.
